INTRODUCTION

The following pages list data for all known family members as of the publication of this book.

The book is split into three primary chapters:

1. Spencer Harvey Shiner
2. The children of Spencer Harvey Shiner
3. The grandchildren of Spencer Harvey shiner

In the first chapter, the ancestor and immediate family are presented in a kind of enhanced Pedigree Chart which displays the graphic representation of their direct-line ancestors and the children of the couple. This chapter contains information about the couple whose offspring are listed in the later chapters.

Each immediate family is presented in their own sub-section that contains a graphical family tree as well as a description with information about each referenced person and their children. The child section provides information about the children of the preceding couple. Roman numerals, followed by a period, are used to indicate the birth order.

The third chapters continue to denote the ancestors of Andrew Shiner in a similar fashion. Details in this chapter are generally less because this series of books is setup to have a book that begins with each person in this section. Relatives are listed in the order of the nearness of their relationship. Each descendant of Andrew Shiner is assigned a number using the d'Aboville System to allow the reader to derive the generation and ancestors of a person using the number through this book and others in the Andrew Shiner Lineage series.

1884 – 1944

Spencer Harvey Shiner was born on Sunday, January 13th, 1884, in Sugarloaf, Luzerne, Pennsylvania. He was the son of John Wesley Shiner (1.1.7.5) and Catherine Mary Johnson.

Spencer died in Nescopeck, Luzerne, Pennsylvania on December 3rd, 1944, at the age of 60. He was buried at Roselawn Cemetery in Berwick, Columbia, Pennsylvania.

At the age of 27, Spencer Harvey married **Blanche Amanda Miller** on Saturday, December 23rd, 1911, in Nescopeck, Luzerne, when she was 21 years old. They had three children.

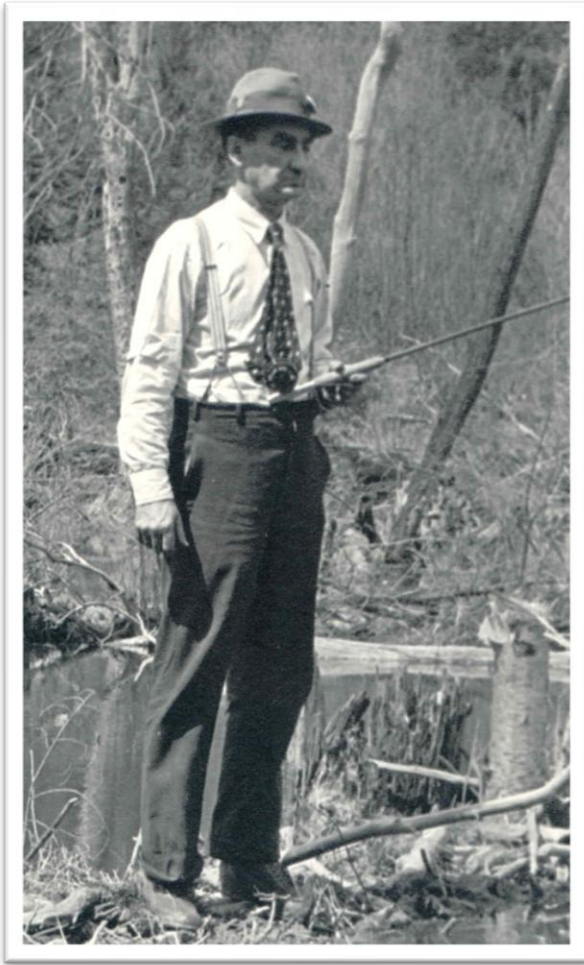
Blanche Amanda was born in Wapwallopen, Luzerne, Pennsylvania on Friday, February 14th, 1890. She was the daughter of John Hiram Miller and Polly Elizabeth Andreas. She was christened on March 12th, 1891. Blanche Amanda reached 84 years of age and died in Nescopeck, Luzerne, Pennsylvania on January 4th, 1975. She was buried at Roselawn Cemetery in Berwick, Columbia, Pennsylvania.

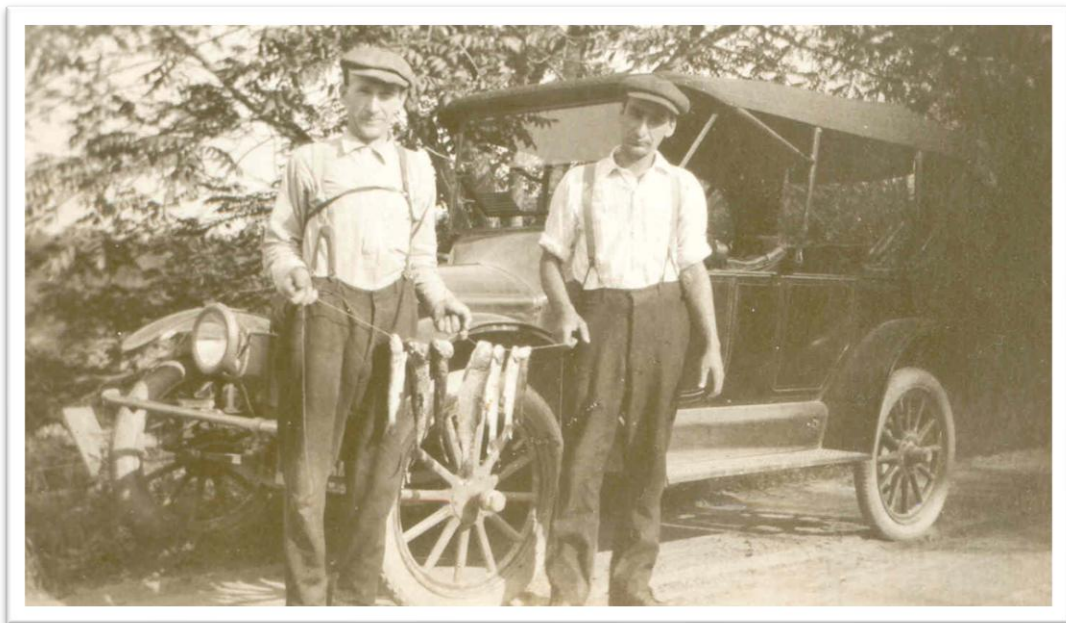

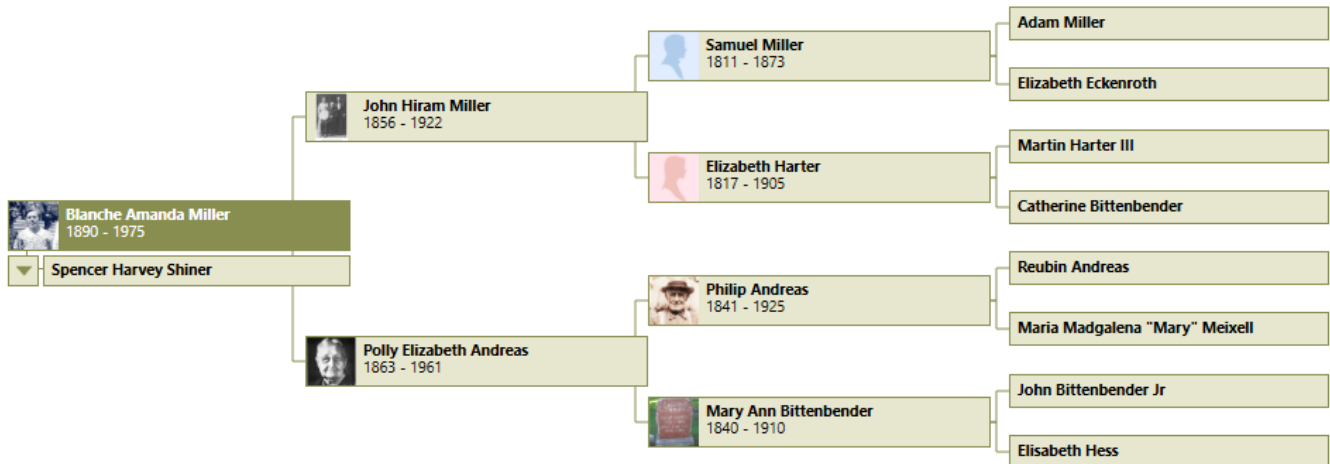

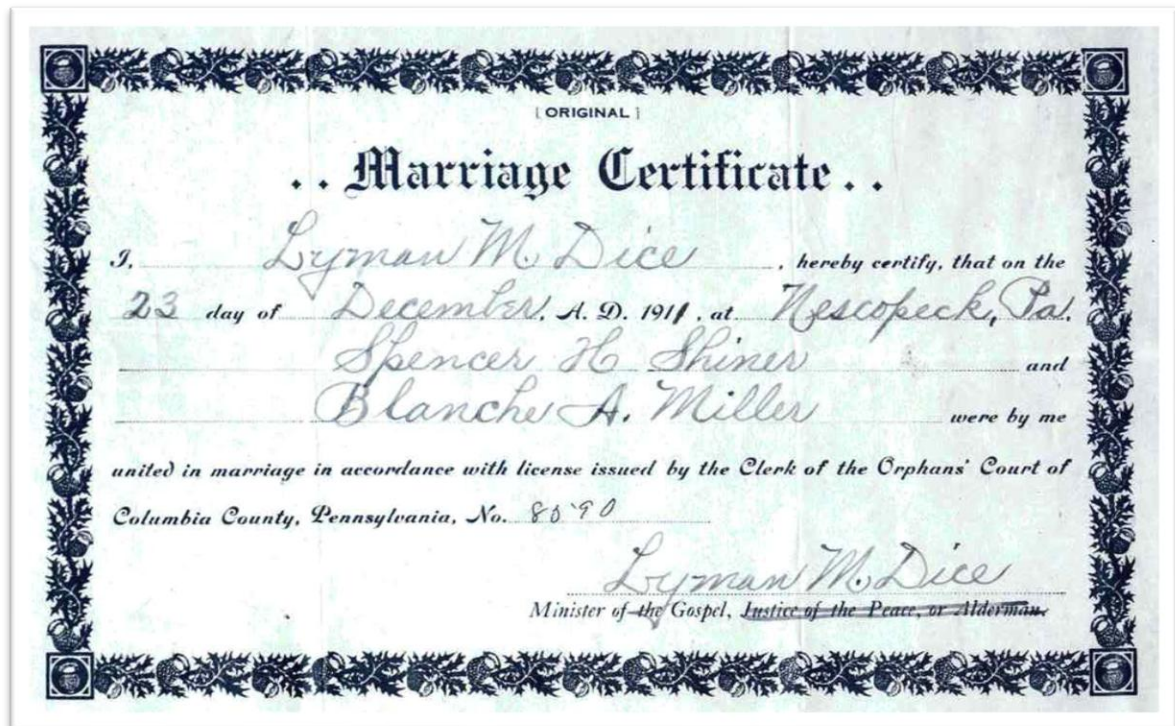

RECORDS OF SPENCER SHINER

A **US Federal Census** of the population of the United States has been taken every ten years by the federal government since 1790. Census records are restricted (not released to the public) for seventy-two years after the census is taken in order to protect the privacy of the individuals surveyed.

The census records from 1790 until 1840 list only the head of the household with counts of the number of persons within the household. Because of this educated guesses must be made to whom these counts refer. Starting in 1850 each individual person in the household was listed on the census. The census records of 1890 are mostly destroyed due to a fire at the Department of Commerce in January 1921.

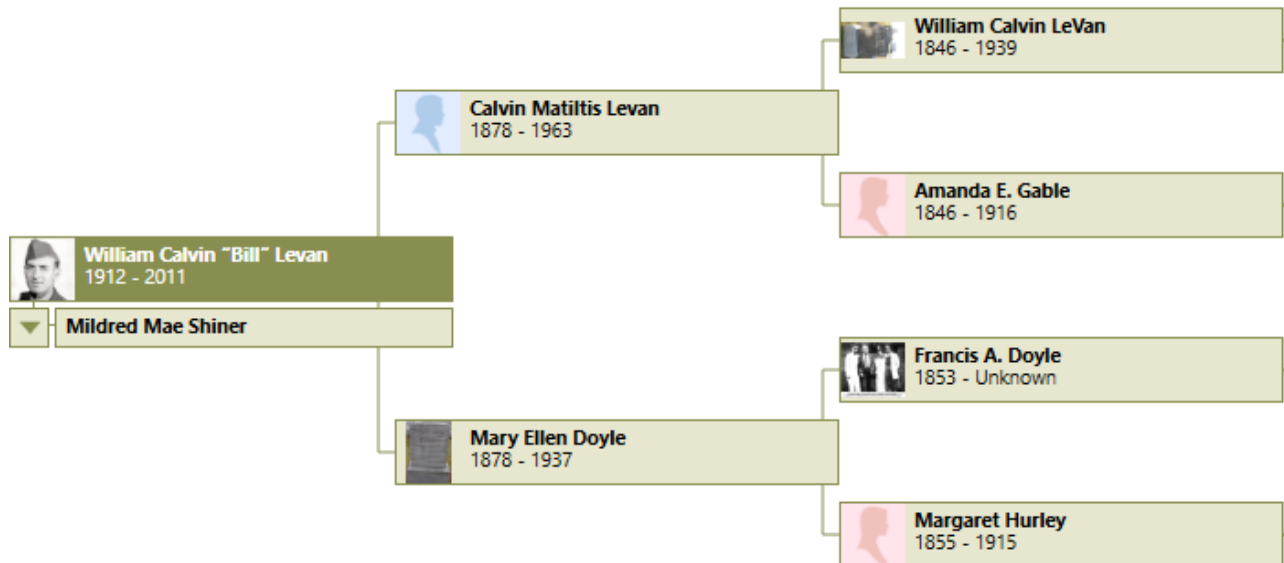

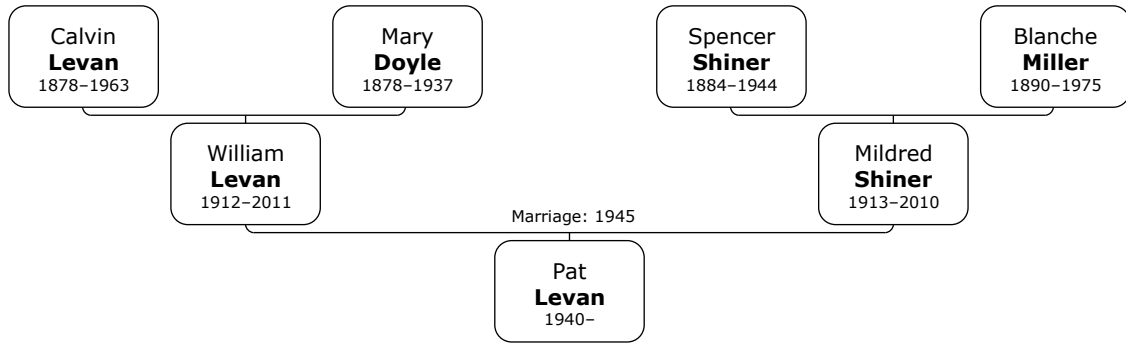

RECORDS OF MILDRED SHINER

A **US Federal Census** of the population of the United States has been taken every ten years by the federal government since 1790. Census records are restricted (not released to the public) for seventy-two years after the census is taken in order to protect the privacy of the individuals surveyed.

The census records from 1790 until 1840 list only the head of the household with counts of the number of persons within the household. Because of this educated guesses must be made to whom these counts refer. Starting in 1850 each individual person in the household was listed on the census. The census records of 1890 are mostly destroyed due to a fire at the Department of Commerce in January 1921.

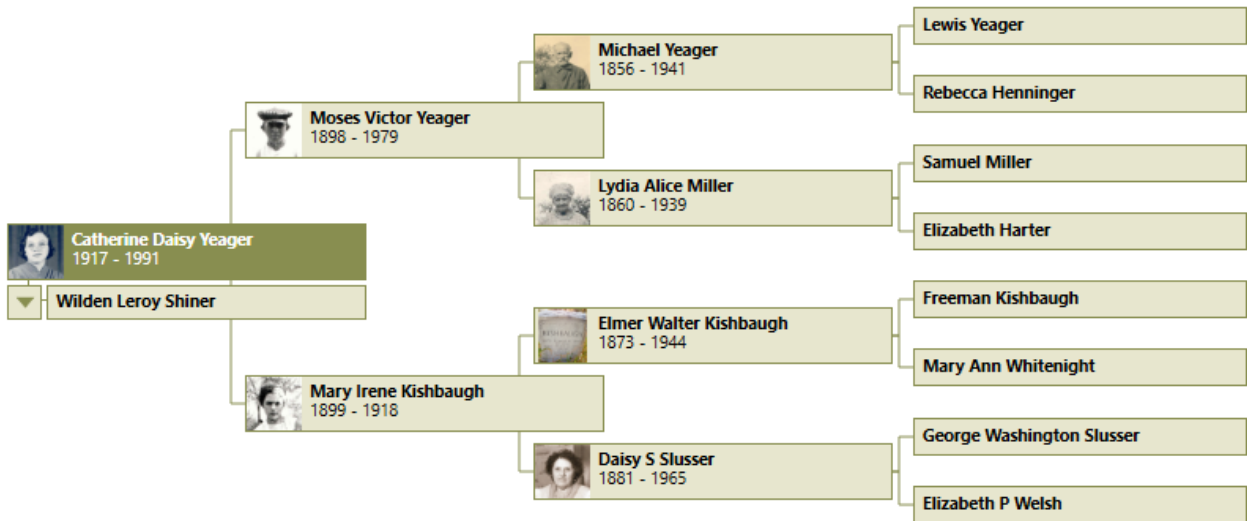

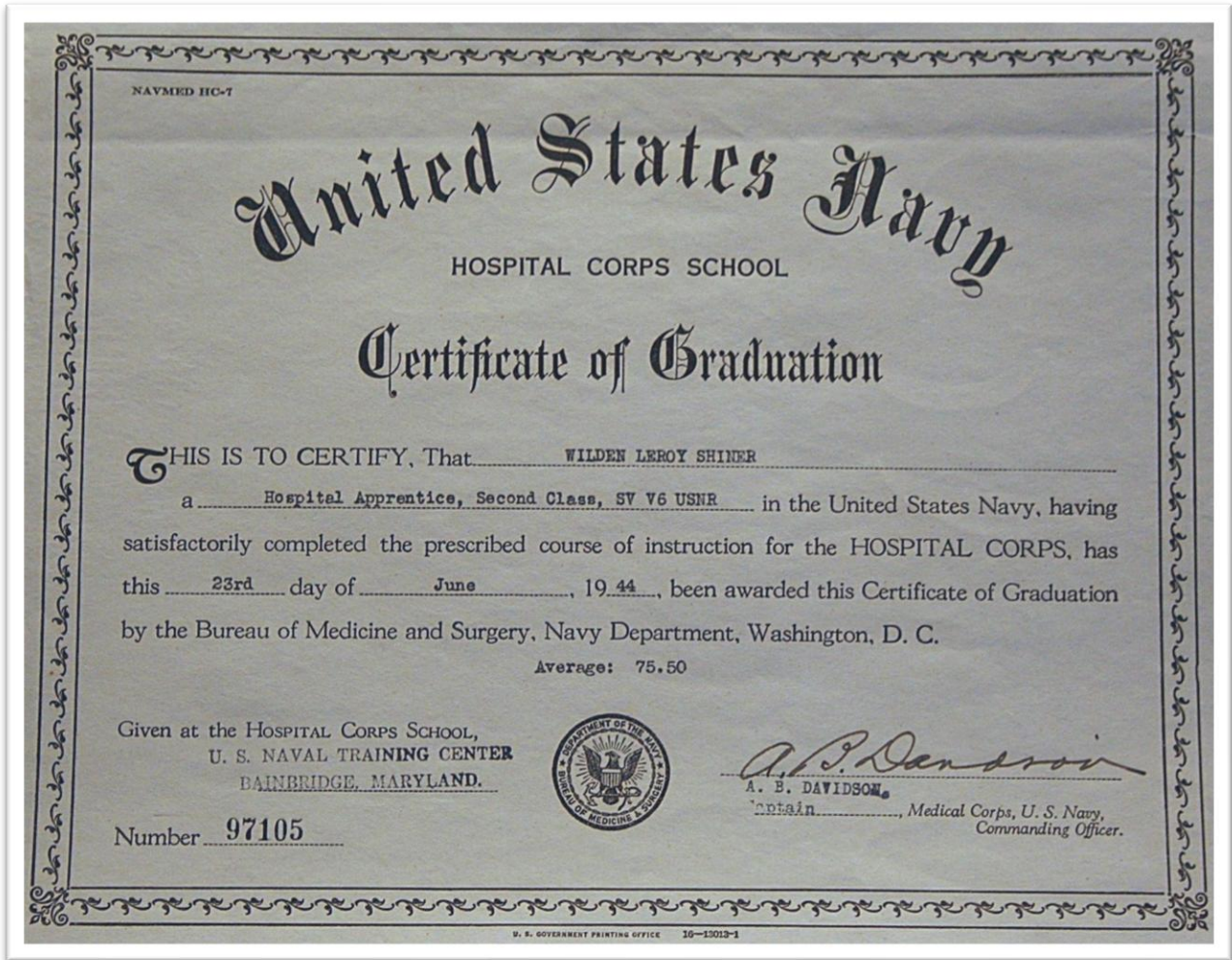

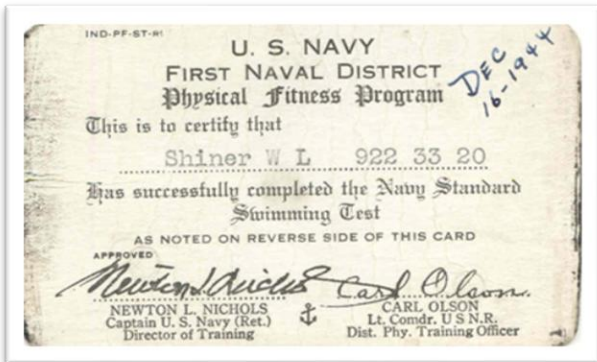


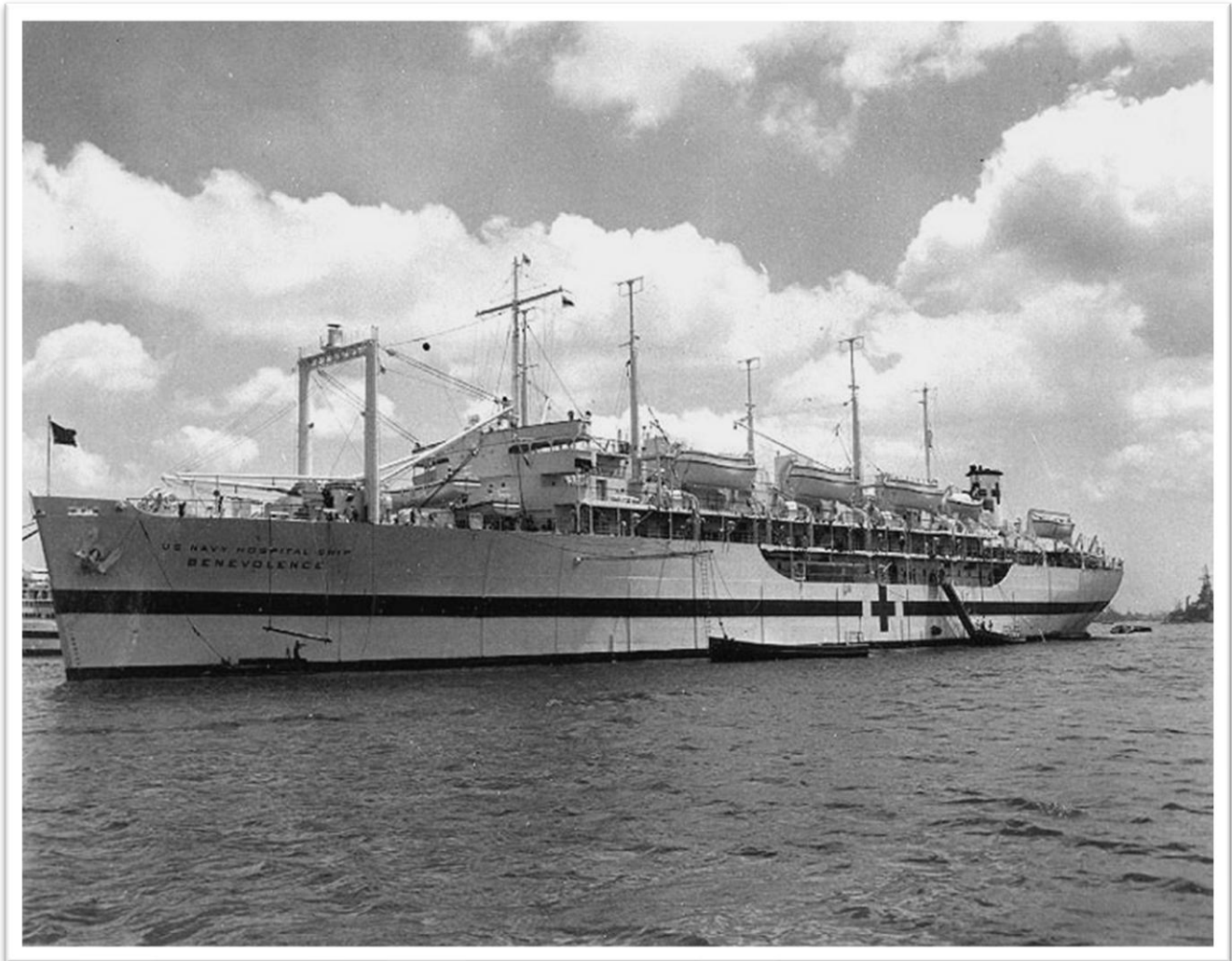

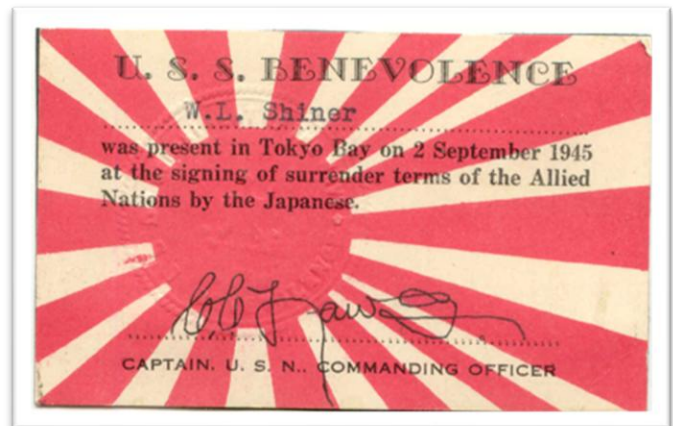
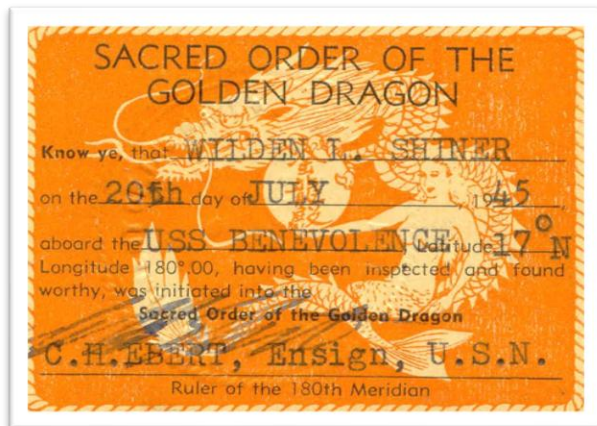

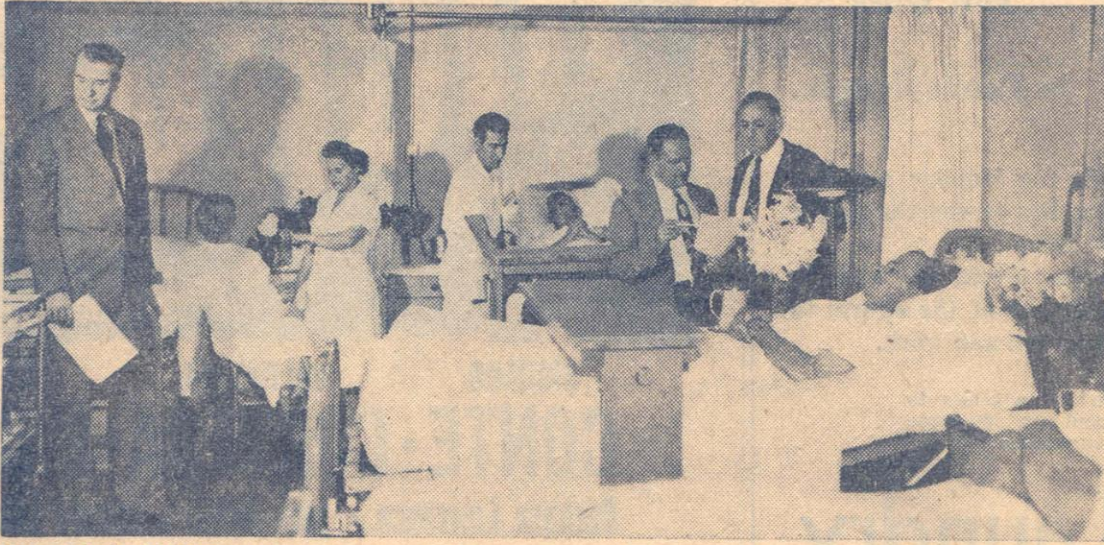

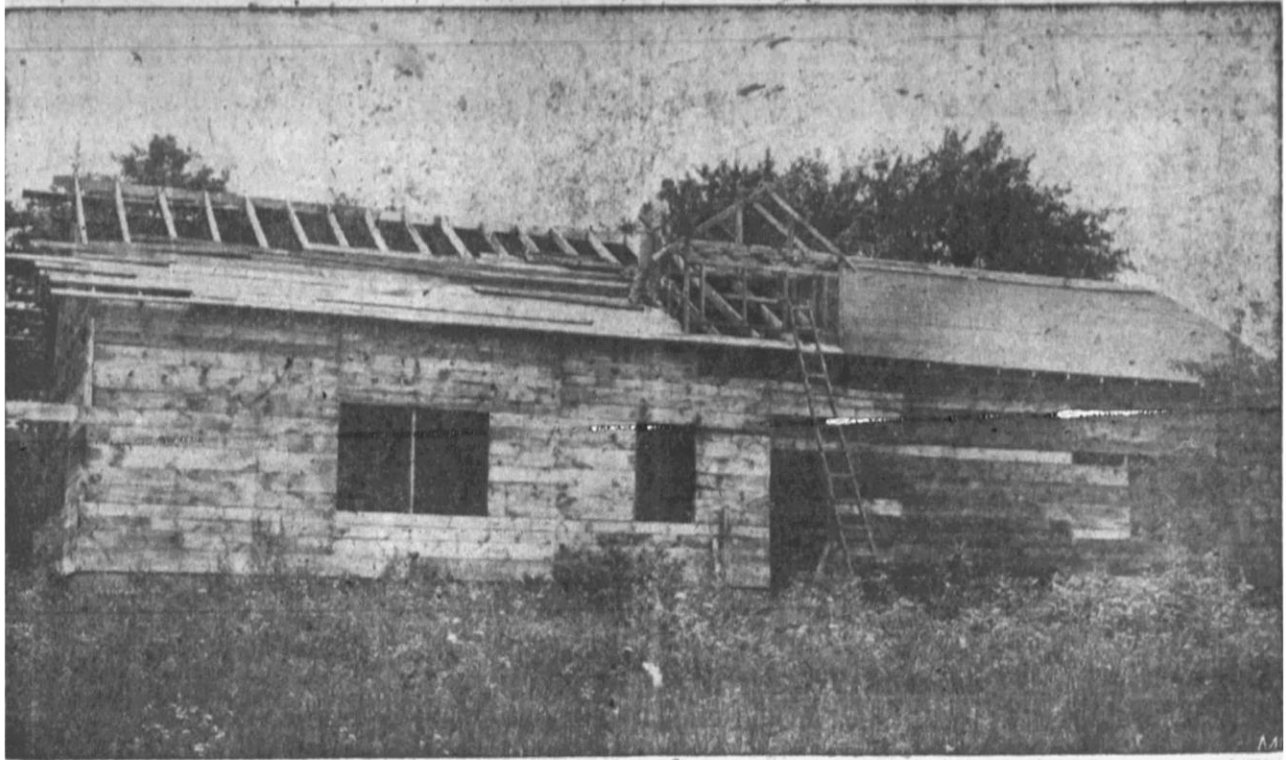

Couple Builds Barn for \$400

War Vet Wilden Shiner Finds a Way; Has Flock Of 100 Geese

Those in military service are ought to find a way to reach the objective and that is what Wilden Shiner, of Nescopeck, R. D. 1, is doing on his forty-seven acre farm

near Zenith.

This war veteran needed a barn to replace the structure which had fallen into such a state that it would not have been practical to repair it.

His capital for the project was limited but he and his wife, working together, are now nearing the completion of a 30x60 foot structure which Shiner designed to meet the needs of the farm.

All of the material from the old barn that could be used was placed in the new structure. Comparatively little had to be purchased, except sheeting and rafters. Part of the cost of this was paid for by selling some of the materials off the old building that he did not need for the new structure. One of the items

sold was a tin roof.

The barn has been under construction since Spring and will be ready for use this Fall. That was only possible, however, by Mr. and Mrs. Shiner putting every minute on the project that was not needed to operate the farm.

Has Over Hundred Geese

The veteran is particularly interested in the raising of geese and this year has a flock of one hundred,

probably one of the largest in the whole area. He reports that he has a good demand for the geese and probably will increase the flock to a marked degree in the years ahead.

He plans to house geese as well as some chickens in part of the new structure. The remainder of the building will be used for the storing of machinery and crops.

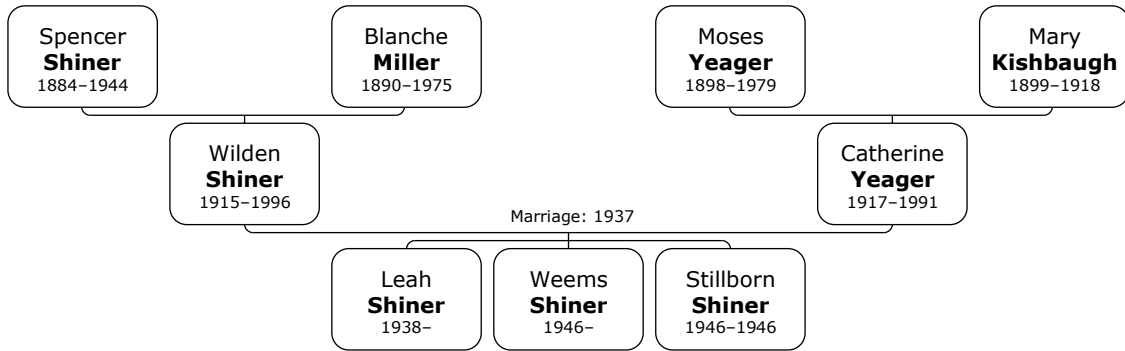

RECORDS OF WILDEN SHINER

A **US Federal Census** of the population of the United States has been taken every ten years by the federal government since 1790. Census records are restricted (not released to the public) for seventy-two years after the census is taken in order to protect the privacy of the individuals surveyed.

The census records from 1790 until 1840 list only the head of the household with counts of the number of persons within the household. Because of this educated guesses must be made to whom these counts refer. Starting in 1850 each individual person in the household was listed on the census. The census records of 1890 are mostly destroyed due to a fire at the Department of Commerce in January 1921.

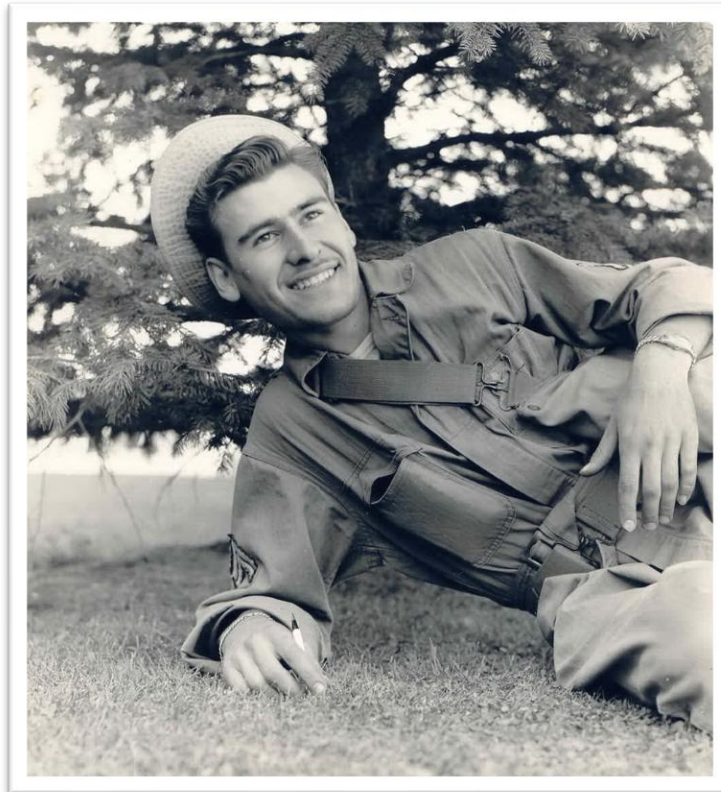

Donald S. Shiner, 65, of 71 Wall St., Nescopeck, died at 10:38 p.m. Sunday in the Berwick Hospital Center. He was in failing health for 14 months.

A life resident of Nescopeck, he was born Jan. 16, 1923, the son of the late Spencer H. and Blanche Miller Shiner.

He graduated from Nescopeck High School in 1941, and Bloomsburg State Teachers College with a degree in biology in 1969.

He was an aerial photographer in the U.S. Air Force H2 315th Bombardment Wing, 20th Air Force for 3½ years during World War II.

Following his service he was photographer for American Car and Foundry and Berwick Forge and Fabricating.

Mr. Shiner was a biology teacher at Berwick High School before retiring in 1979.

As a conservationist he was an accomplished writer and photographer. Many articles were published in the Philadelphia Inquirer, "Today Magazine" and many of his photos have appeared in the Press-Enterprise.

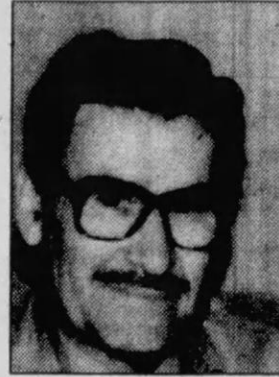
He was a life member of St. Mark's Lutheran Church, Nescopeck.

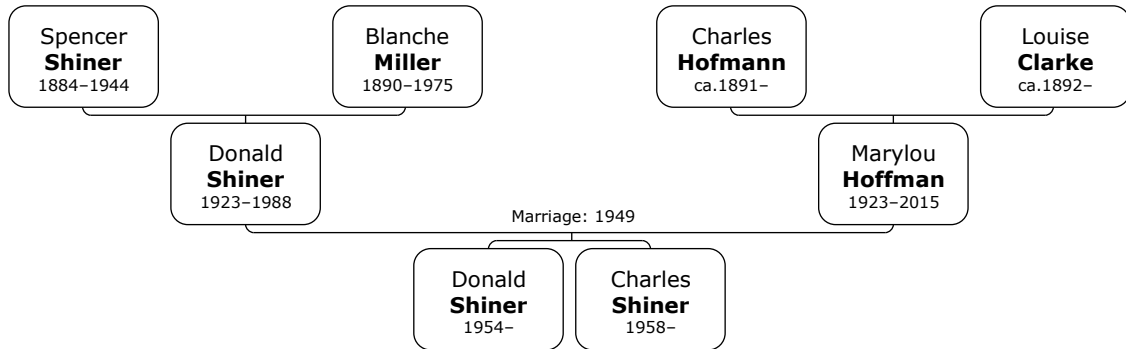

Because of this educated guesses must be made to whom these counts refer. Starting in 1850 each individual person in the household was listed on the census. The census records of 1890 are mostly destroyed due to a fire at the Department of Commerce in January 1921.

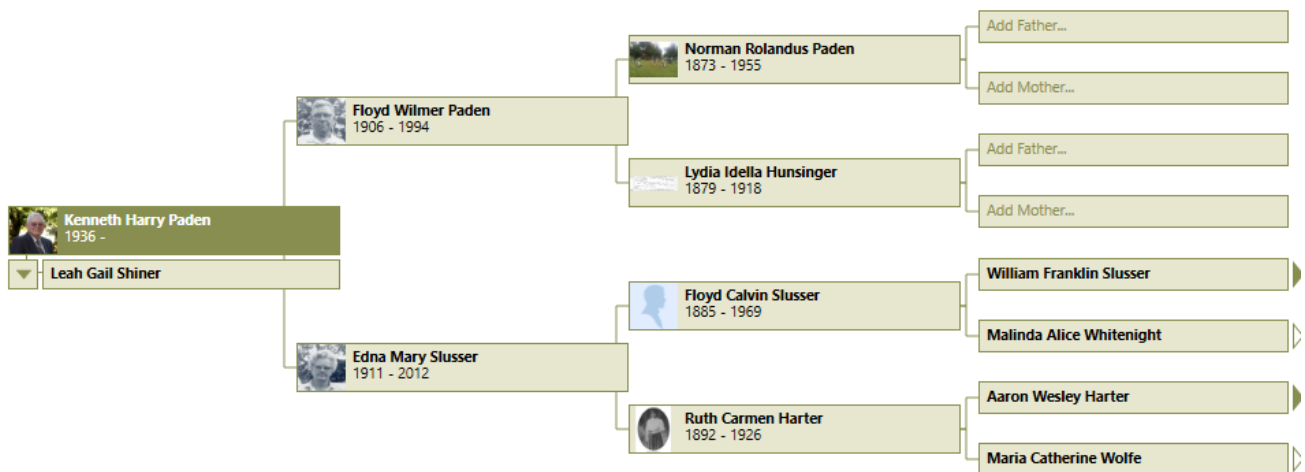

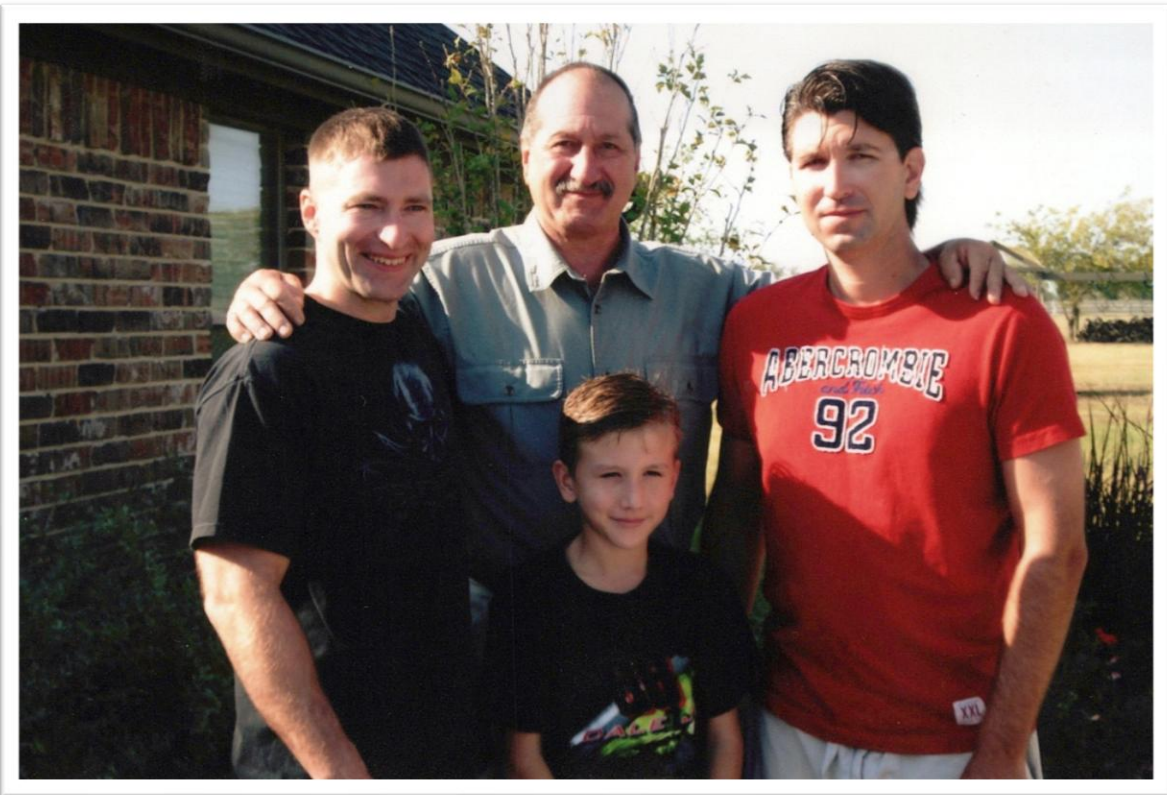

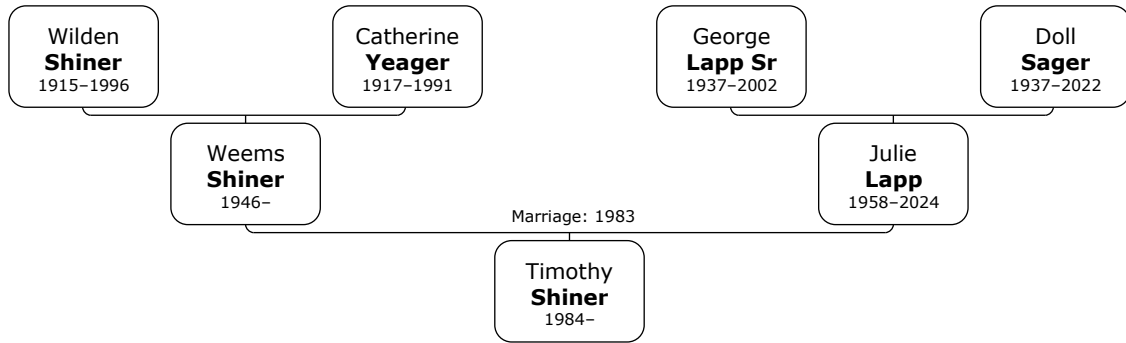
